Credit System

- A credit hour is a unit of time and effort for a class—typically one hour per week for each credit. A three- credit class, for example, might meet twice a week. Total credit hours for the semester show your overall workload.
- Cumulative Credit Hour keeps track of all the credits you have earned. It
 is like your academic mileage. Meeting your program's cumulative credit
 hour requirement means you are on track to complete it successfully.
- Understand your graduation credit requirements and plan your semesters accordingly.
- Do not rush; take on a manageable credit load that allows for a well-rounded learning experience.
- If you postpone, defer a semester, or drop a course, it might create challenges later on. Some courses may be unavailable, such as the prerequisite courses, which may have an impact on your progress. Speak with your advisor about it; they will guide you through the credit system and assist you in making sound academic decisions.
- Attendance is mandatory for all classes. According to university regulations and policy, missing classes without a valid reason can affect your exam performance or lead to termination.

Academic Study

This section summarizes your academic journey in two informative tables. The first table shows the academic CGPA status, and the grading system is explained in the second table. These tables are useful resources for your academic journey.

- If a student is placed on probation for three consecutive semesters, their studies will be terminated.
- As part of the remedial process, the student is required to fill out a pledge during the second probation.
- A GPA of 3.67 or higher every semester places you on the Dean's List for outstanding performance.
- After completing all semesters with a CGPA of 3.67 or higher, you are awarded the prestigious Dean's Award for overall excellence.

Attendance and Permission

Attending classes is vital for your academic success. Regular attendance is a cornerstone for a smooth transition into university life, ensuring you make the most of your educational journey from the start. Active participation in your classes will set a positive tone for a successful and fulfilling first year.

Key Points to Keep in Mind

- Absences and late arrivals are documented and can affect your grades.
- Students automatically receive three warnings (first, second, and last) via email.
- Upon reaching the last warning, a meeting with faculty is necessary to fill out the pledge form.
- After completing the pledge form, students are not permitted to be absent.
- Permission is granted in two situations: first, in cases of illness, according to QIU guidelines; and second, in the unfortunate event of a student-related emergency.
- During class, students are only permitted 5 minutes for an urgent break.
 Longer breaks are at the discretion of the lecturer; please notify your lecturer and return on time.
- If you become ill, visit the Health and Safety Office for assistance.
- During academic semesters, the faculty approves medical reports.
 However, during midterm and final exams, approval from the Examination Committee is required.

Communication

- Regularly communicate with your lecturers; they are there to support you in your academic journey.
- Address issues or problems directly with your lecturers; seek resolutions through proper channels. If necessary, involve your representative, head of department, dean, and relevant authorities respectfully.
