




Greetings from QIU!






Building Partnerships

QIU has continuously developed beneficial alliances and partnerships aimed at supporting academic excellence and encouraging innovation.

Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs)

QIU expanded its network of strategic partnerships by signing several Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) with esteemed organisations and institutions.



In an effort to support environmental sustainability and conservation efforts in the Kurdistan region, a recent Memorandum of Understanding was signed with the Rwanga Foundation on February 6, 2024.



On November 16, 2023, we reached an agreement with the Sulaimani Branch of the Health Workers Union to promote professional development and capacity-building initiatives for healthcare professionals.



On October 16, 2023, a Memorandum of Understanding was signed with President Mam Jalal Organisation to foster cooperation and collaboration in mutually beneficial areas such as education, research, and community development.

These strategic partnerships reinforce QIU's mission of excellence in education, research, and community engagement, emphasising the institution's commitment to interdisciplinary collaboration, knowledge exchange, and social impact.

International Collaborations and Initiatives

Initiatives in the Local Community

On January 29, 2024, a delegation from Qaiwan International University led by Hewr Abdullah Ismail (Registration and Admissions Coordinator) visited the British International School. The team delivered a seminar on topics such as the Malaysian education system at QIU, study programmes, international degrees, and job opportunities. Furthermore, Sima Jaza, a QIU graduate and top student in the Faculty of Engineering and Computer Science who is now an employee at QIU, highlighted QIU's unique opportunities. During the visit, she shared her success story of receiving a full scholarship from UTM to pursue her master's degree.

QIU Launches New Centres and Directorates

We are pleased to announce the opening of three new centres and one Directorates at Qaiwan International University that will serve the wider community. They are dedicated to improving learning and career development opportunities for not only our faculty, staff, students, and alumni but also members of the larger community.

1. Training and Development Centre (TDC)

The TDC at Qaiwan International University provides a diverse range of programmes aimed at providing individuals with essential skills and knowledge. These programmes include high-quality continuing education courses, which are essential for success in today's dynamic professional landscape. Our training methods are cutting-edge, allowing for professional growth through shorter courses. We also create and modify content to meet specific requirements. Furthermore, the TDC paves the way through the QIU Pre-Academic English Programme and Language Learning courses for both university applicants seeking to meet the academic program's entry requirements and those interested in improving their English language skills while also requiring the IELTS qualification. Significantly, from December 2023 to January 2024, officers and staff of the Sulaimani Police Directorate received specialised cybercrime investigation training as part of a TDC initiative.









2. Pedagogy Training and Academic Development Centre

The Pedagogy Training and Academic Development Centre at Qaiwan International University is a dedicated space for educators to explore the art and science of teaching. Our mission is to empower educators with the knowledge and skills needed to excel in today's dynamic educational landscape. We are thrilled to announce the start of our first pedagogical course, which started on January 15, 2024. This course will last six months, with sessions scheduled twice a week. It is designed to provide educators with practical training and insights to enhance their teaching strategies and professional development.

3. Career Development Centre (CDC)

The CDC is committed to empowering individuals to navigate their careers and achieve professional success. Services and offerings include:

- **Career Counselling:** Personalised guidance tailored to individual career aspirations.
- **Resume Building:** Assistance in creating effective resumes that will leave a lasting impression in the job market.
- Interview Preparation: Coaching and practise sessions to improve interview skills and confidence.
- **Job Search Support:** Tools and techniques to simplify the job search procedure.
- **Professional Development Workshops:** Ongoing workshops covering topics such as networking, personal branding, and career planning.
- Internship Opportunities: Access to a diverse range of internship placements across various industries.
- **Alumni Relations with Companies:** Facilitating connections with QIU alumni in key positions in leading companies.
- **Networking Events with Industry Leaders:** Opportunities to engage with industry representatives through networking events and workshops.
 - **Career Fairs and Recruitment Events:** Connecting students with potential employers via career fairs and recruitment events.
- **Career Coaching and Mentoring Programmes:** One-on-one coaching sessions and mentoring programmes for personalised career guidance.
- **Entrepreneurship Support:** Guidance, resources, and mentorship for aspiring entrepreneurs.
- **Professional Certification Programmes:** Offering professional certification programmes to enhance credentials and expertise.

Highlights of Faculty Achievements

Our esteemed faculty members continue to demonstrate their commitment to excellence in their scholarly pursuits, research endeavours, and community engagement.

Highlights from the past months include:

The Faculty of Pharmacy held a series of educational events, including workshops and seminars led by guest speakers, such as Skincare' with Dr. Mohammed Yousef Jaff, a skincare and cosmetic specialist, on January 15, 2024, and a seminar on 'The Mental Well-Being of Men' by Dr. Zana Ahmed Qasab, a renowned psychiatrist, on November 21, 2023, in collaboration with the QIU Mental Health Awareness Club.

The Faculty of Dentistry organised a workshop presented by Dr. Mohammed Haji. The workshop, "Posterior Composite Restoration," titled attended by dentists and dental students from various universities in Sulaimani. It was divided into two parts: a theoretical session with 63 participants and a practical session with 24 dentists and dental students on February 11, 2024. In another initiative, students from the Faculty of Dentistry at Qaiwan International University, in collaboration with KDHO, visited the Tofiq Sheikh Tayeb Educational Center. The purpose of the visit was to conduct dental check-ups for the students of the educational centre on November 13, 2023.

The Faculty of Health Sciences organised a series of awareness campaigns and events, including Breast Cancer Awareness Campaign, World Radiography Day, and Sulaimani Diabetes Meeting, aimed at promoting health awareness and education.

hosted seminars and webinars on topics ranging from biomedical challenges to the ICT job market, giving students valuable insights into industry trends and opportunities.
